SCOPE Education Services is a not-for-profit organization that has been providing services to Long Island school districts since 1964. In 1992 SCOPE opened the After School Child Care Program for Uniondale families. The success of this licensed program is attributed to the dedication of the Site Director, Jennifer Bellamy, who has successfully run this program for 25 years and counting. Ms. Bellamy is a certified teacher who is known for her professionalism, commitment and caring demeanor, along with her Assistant of more than 20 years, who have made a tremendous impact in the Uniondale community. During this time of uncertainty, be assured that this highly qualified and seasoned SCOPE staff will provide your child with a safe, fun and caring environment with age-appropriate educational and recreational activities and additional homework support in a 1:10 staff to student ratio. Your child will also receive a USDA approved snack each afternoon and have daily opportunities to participate with their peers in recreational and enrichment activities including exciting STEAM and literacy activities that promote character development.

HOW TO REGISTER

Registration is on-line only through the SCOPE website. Parents must create an online account and complete a registration contract at scopeonline.us. A new contract must be submitted each school year and placement is confirmed in the order in which contracts are received.

MONTHLY TUITION (fees are subject to change)

Consistent Schedule: Child attends every day that school is in session.

PM: \$334/month

Pick Your Days: Child attends a minimum of 5 days monthly. All days must be pre-selected online by the 15th of the month prior.

PM: \$96.50/month (\$19.30 per day over 5)

There is an annual registration fee of \$40 (or \$60 per family) that is payable upon enrollment.

There is a 20% sibling discount for 2nd child; 40% for 3rd child

*Subsidies are available to income eligible families.

There will be an additional COVID-19 surcharge of \$8.00 (part time) or \$15.00 (full time) per child charged to your account each month. Please note that SCOPE will follow all OCFS regulations and COVID-19 guidelines including daily health checks with thermometers for all staff and children, face masks, social distancing and sanitizing.
